Criteria 6.5.3 Annual Report of the Institution 2023 -2024

Since in 2023-2024 we engaged a diverse range of activities, our academic institutional report has the multilayered strands for the enumeration here. The most remarkable one to start with was the hosting of an international conference in a hybrid mode. This stimulating conference on Renegotiating the Globalized Nationalities: A SAARC Dialogue was solid in its scholarly and thematic calling and for that reason it could secure the funding from the central agency called ICSSR. Its stellar panels and plenary sessions around transdisciplinary approach was well received. The seasoned scholars from Bangladesh, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Maldives and Delhi added academic sheen to the conference discourse and deliberation. Second noteworthy event our college hosted early in 2024 was National level conference encompassing recent trends in commerce. Not leaving students behind we also created an online platform to host two days National Multidisciplinary students' conference.

To ensure research publication remains a regular phenomenon some of our faculties got their qualitative 13 research works published. And our star faculty of history received prestigious research projects worth 18.2 lakhs to 16 lakhs from the IKS division of the Ministry of Education and the American University of Sharjah respectively. She was invited by the Indian embassy of Muscat to deliver a public lecture in Muscat. Our two faculties completed their doctorate research and six of the other budding faculties are pursuing their respective Ph.Ds. our students are not legging behind in the research and innovation as 4 teams participated in Avishkar Research Convention and the team psychology qualified for the Zonal round.

In the field of sports our college recorded impressive achievements. Out of 11 medals 6 Gold medals, 4 silver medals and 1 bronze medal along with some crucial qualifiers.

At the department level all departments engaged 5 or more activities which ensured all round cognitive and intellectual growth of the students as they were engaged in debate, elocution, quizzing, gaming, history hackathon, field visits, thematic fests, poster making, film appreciation career guidance among others. The committees too were proactive in hosting number of statutory, staff and student centric activities which numbered around 50 plus. For instance, NSS dynamically casted wider net over 41 activities out of which 26 were distinct and niche ones. Placement cell could acquire 20 placements for the students from 18 companies. The research committee organized 3 conferences and mentored Avishkar as stated above. Women Development Cell configured 4 women centric activities and Cultural Forum ensured vibrant events right from the freshers' welcome party to the multicolored and annual intercollegiate fest namely Utkarsh with 40 contests reconfirmed college's holistic grounding.
